New and Amended Policies

Section 2.02 - Code of Ethics for Board of Directors and General Manager/Chief Executive officer

Conflicts Disclosure Statements

- Lowered reporting requirement on gifts received from vendors from \$250 to \$100
- Added new "Family Relationship" reporting requirement
 - If a vendor (including an employee of the vendor) is related to a Board Member within the 3rd degree of consanguinity or 2nd degree of affinity, then the Board Member must file a conflicts disclosure statement.
 - 3rd degree of consanguinity (blood) Spouses, parents, children, siblings, grandparents, great grandparents, grandchildren, great grandchildren, aunts/uncles, nieces/nephews
 - 2nd degree of affinity (marriage) Children, spouses, parents, brothers/sisters, grandparents, grandchildren, aunts/uncles



Conflicts Disclosure Statements cont'd

- Extended to employees
- Penalties:
 - Class C misdemeanor: contract value less than \$1,000,000
 - Fine not to exceed \$500
 - Class B misdemeanor: contract value \$1,000,000 to \$5,000,000
 - Fine not to exceed \$2,000 and/or confinement in jail, not to exceed 180 days
 - Class A misdemeanor: contract value \$5,000,000 or more
 - Fine not to exceed \$4,000 and/or confinement in jail, not to exceed 1 year



Limitations of Indemnification of the Brazos River Authority by Engineer or Architect

- Cannot require an Engineer or Architect to defend BRA against a claim based wholly or partially on BRA's (or BRA's agent's) negligence, fault, or breach of contract.
- Establishes the standard of care an engineer or architect must use when providing services.
 - same or similar locality
 - under the same or similar circumstances

4.3 - Financial Audit

Submittal of Annual Fiscal Report

• BRA's annual fiscal report must be filed with the Texas Comptroller



6.03 - Real Property Rights

• If BRA acquires property through Eminent Domain, BRA must file a report regarding such acquisition with the Texas Comptroller.

Energy Efficiency Program

• At least once every five years evaluate electricity consumption, establish goals to reduce electricity consumption, and identify and implement cost-effective energy efficiency measures to reduce electricity consumption

Miscellaneous

• Minor edits and corrections for clarity and consistency throughout the document.
