Texas Clean Rivers Act

- Texas Water Code, Section 26.0135
- Passed in 1991, reauthorized in 1997
- Goals
 - Comprehensive water quality planning and management
 - Ensure state has a safe, clean water supply
 - Requires on-going assessment of water quality
- Mandates that TCEQ partner with river authorities



Contract for FY 2016 & FY 2017

- Total \$796,318
- No match required
- Effective date:
 September 1, 2015





The following resolution is presented for consideration to the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority for adoption at its July 27, 2015 meeting:

"BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to enter into a contract with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), whereby TCEQ will provide funding, in the amount of \$796,318.00 to the Brazos River Authority to perform water quality monitoring services and other activities under the Texas Clean Rivers Program."
