


WCRRWL Operations

- ~ 200,000 Residents Served in Williamson County
- Annual Demands: 30,000 40,000 Acre-feet
- Lake Georgetown Supply: ~ 12,000 Acre-feet
- WCRRWL Pumpage:
 - Annual Average: 16,471 Acre-feet
 - Peak: 36,591 Acre-feet, 2014



Lake Georgetown Projections

Current Demands with No Pumping (Prepared by BRA Water Services, September 2016)



Assumptions:

- CDM Operation Model
- No Pumping
- Worst Inflows with Current Demand for Period Beginning September 1995
- Current Demand of 35,551 AF
