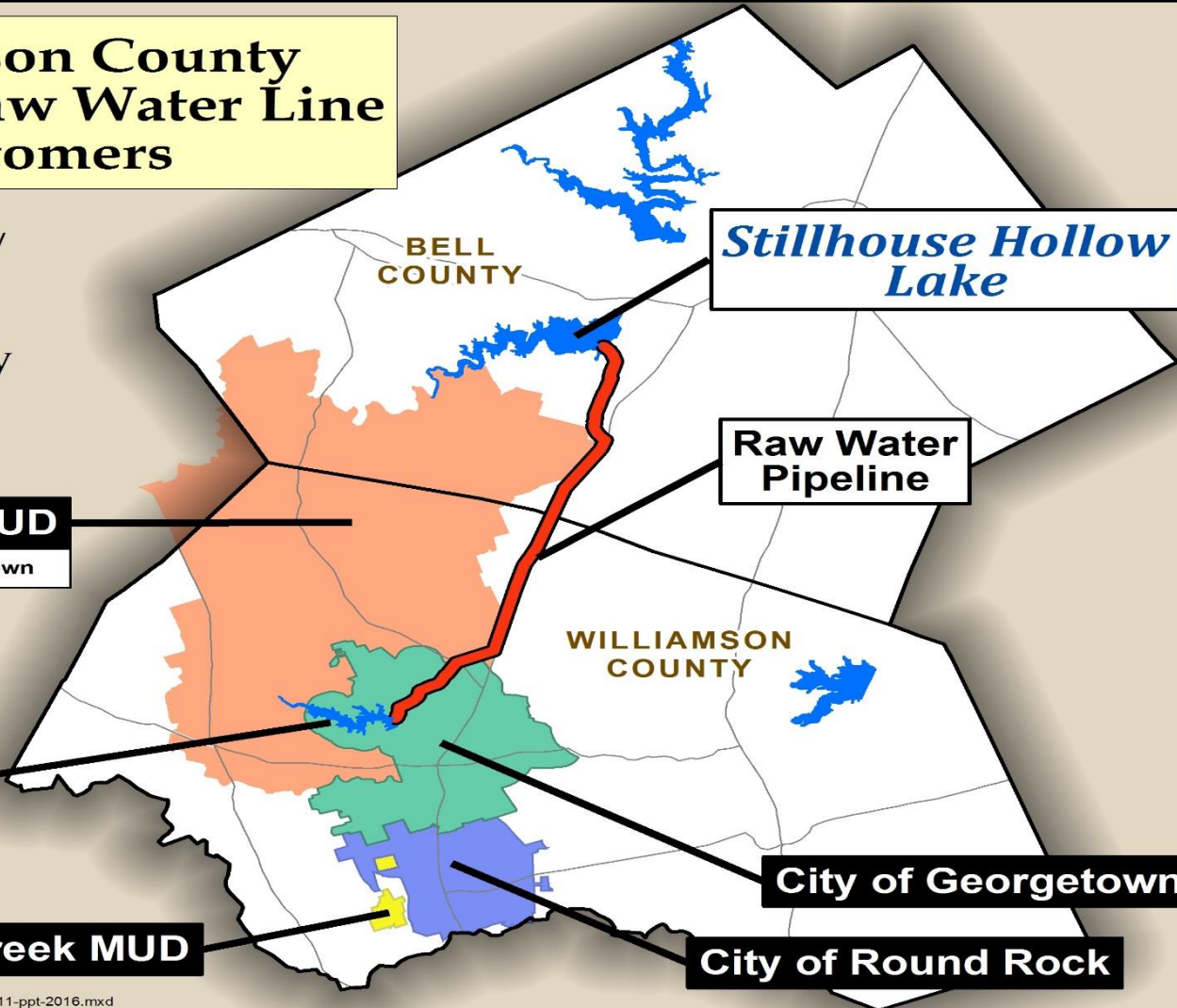

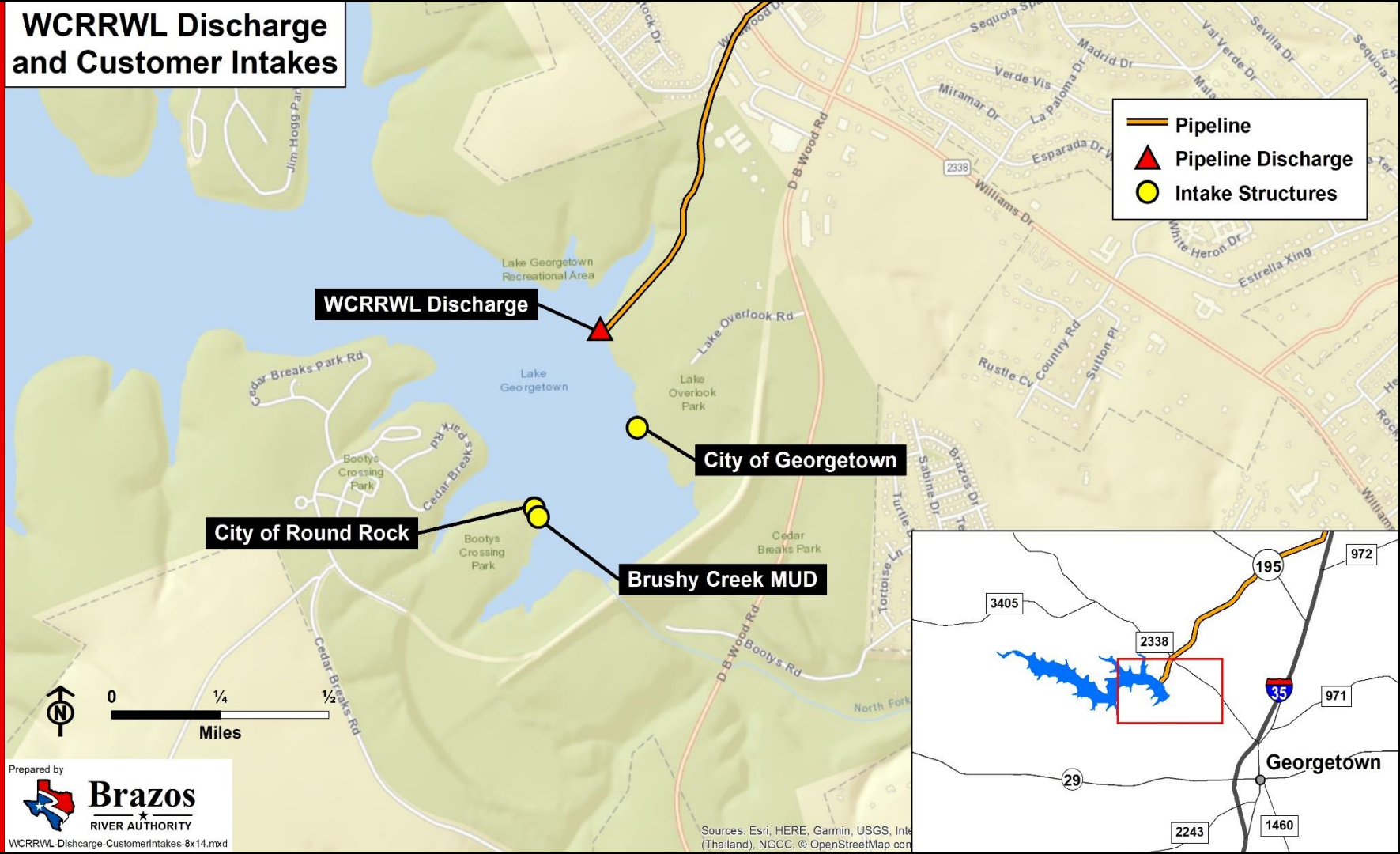

“BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Round Rock, the City of Georgetown, and the Brushy Creek Municipal Utility District to evaluate Zebra Mussel control strategies for water diversion and treatment infrastructure at Lake Georgetown and for the Williamson County Regional Raw Water Line and associated intake structure at Lake Stillhouse Hollow.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute a professional services contract with Walker Partners for an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for engineering and technical services required for the evaluation of Zebra Mussel control strategies, which will be funded by the City of Round Rock, the City of Georgetown, and the Brushy Creek Municipal Utility District.”
