


















"BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the **Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the** General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Round Rock, the City of Georgetown, and the Brushy Creek **Municipal Utility District to evaluate Zebra Mussel** control strategies for water diversion and treatment infrastructure at Lake Georgetown and for the Williamson County Regional Raw Water Line and associated intake structure at Lake Stillhouse Hollow.
