What is Interruptible Water?

- Firm water from reservoirs not used in the previous year
- Amount available varies from year to year depending on weather and higher water usage
- Availability established annually by the Board in October
- Sold at System Rate (Ag Rate for irrigation)
- Began supplying in 2008


IW Sale Procedure

- Establishes calculation methodology, application, and allocation process
- Calculation method includes Safety Factor established by the Board
 - Protects/ensures long-term contracts aren't impacted
- Multi-year contracts get "first shot" at available water
- Diversions can be curtailed when any reservoir in the System reaches its Stage 3 Drought Emergency Trigger
- The last of the multi-year contracts will expire at the end of 2021
- Priority given to requests of 1,000 acre-feet and less when allocating the available water
