Current Status of Environmental Services (ES) Laboratory

- Three independent reviews have cited deficiencies in:
 - No room for new equipment or to increase number of existing analyses
 - Not enough room to comply with manufacturers recommended space requirements for equipment
 - Insufficient on-site storage space
 - No workshop space
 - Environmental controls inadequate
 - Industry standards for safety

Needs Assessment and Feasibility Study

- Request for Proposal
 - Four proposals received
- Contract executed with Gresham Smith in FY 2018
- Gresham Smith
 - Architecture and engineering firm
 - Experienced in both building and laboratory design



Gresham Smith Contract Tasks

- Evaluate current work process, workspace and workflow analysis for Waco-based Departments
- Develop workspace need estimates for anticipated growth
- Develop workspace improvement concepts
- Develop workspace improvement plans
- Work completed before Covid-19 crisis



Initial Conclusions

- Central Office has a net need of 24,232 sq-ft
- Central Office will likely reach maximum capacity within 15 years even after implementing GS recommendations for reconfiguration
- Projected CO Workspace deficiencies can be met within the existing footprint of CO, if the following occur:
 - Construction of Environmental Operations Facility (EOF) Off-site
 - Inclusion of Safety and Security Department in EOF
 - Structured modifications to CO to more efficiently utilize existing space



Internal Analysis Considering Lessons Learned from Pandemic

- Central Office space needs vary by department but all plan to rely on some level of remote work
- EOF may not need to be constructed off-site



Scenarios for Laboratory Expansion on Site

- Expand Environmental Lab within the current footprint of the Central Office Buildling
 - Build on site storage for equipment and workshop
 - Reconfigure part of Central Office to create workstations for remote works
- Build Lab on-site adjacent to Central Office
 - Includes storage for equipment and workshop

Time and Cost

- Cost of Evaluation of Two Scenarios \$20,810
- Work will be complete in X months of execution of the amendment



Next Steps

- Complete evaluation of two Central Office scenarios
- Review all options and scenarios
- Make recommendation for path forward
