Major Issues

- Budget
 - Outlook better than initially expected
- Redistricting
 - Several bills filed, least likely to get done
- Covid
 - Multitude of bills on different aspects
- Electricity
 - In response to winter storm, dominant issue right now



Other Issues

- Broadband
 - Expansion of broadband, particularly to rural TX
- Public meetings
 - Multiple bills filed to expand use of virtual meetings by govt entities
- Public funds for lobbying
 - Two different versions, one limited to cities and counties only
- Eminent Domain
 - Several bills refiled from last session



Water Issues

- Produced water
 - Bill filed to study expanding use of water from oil and gas process
- Groundwater/Surface water Interaction
 - Multiple bills filed to study the issue
- Groundwater
 - Usual GW issues such as loser pays, appeals processes for permittees
- TPWD bills
 - Bills filed regarding TPWD standing in water right permits and promotion of Water Trust



River Authority Specific

- Presiding Officer Designation
 - Requires Gov designation of PO, filed last session
 - Two versions, one applying to RA's only and one to all entities under Sunset
- Election of RA Board Members
 - Interim study on electing Board members to RA's
 - Would look at adding two elected members and adding one while reducing appointed by one



BRA Sunset

- Filed last Tuesday
- Includes following across-the-board provisions
 - Grounds for Board member removal
 - Requirement for Board member training
 - Requirement for public testimony at Board meetings
 - Requirement of policy separating Board (policy-making) and staff functions
 - Requirement to maintain complaint tracking system
