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Lake Limestone Fiber Optic Upgrade Project

- Lake Limestone data transfer rate is maxed out at 6Mbps and is impacted by environmental conditions resulting in frequent outages of service
- Lake Limestone communication with Central Office staff and the public is adversely impacted and often disrupted
- Increase in network bandwidth and more reliable service are necessary to maintain Lake Limestone operations



- Total Project Cost = \$616K
- This project will install 14 miles of fiber optic cable
- Similar projects were recently completed at PK and EWC



"BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to negotiate and execute a special construction agreement with AT&T for the installation of fiber optic cable to BRA's Lake Limestone office for an amount not to exceed \$616,000".









- Total Project Cost = \$616K
- Quote expires Jun 19, 2021
- BRA will utilize an agreement between Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) and AT&T
- BRA received a Special Construction Agreement (SCA) for installation of 14 miles of fiber optic cable
- BRA has sought to share the cost of construction with local entities but has not been successful due to rural proximity and lack of commerce in the area



- BOD Approval May 24
- Execute special construction agreement
- Complete construction by end of August
