Summary

- Four million gallon per day plant and reuse facility
- Four BRA employees
- Treats wastewater from the Cities of Clute and Richwood
- BRA has been operating the facility since Oct. 1, 2000, under a cost-reimbursable contract
- Original 20-year contract expired last year and was extended for one year
- The one-year extension expires September 30, 2021
- Cities have requested another one-year extension while they consider long-term options
- 2022 budget is approximately \$858,163; BRA Management Fee is \$42,908
- Recommend Board grant authorization for General Manager/CEO to execute one-year contract extension

"WHEREAS, the Brazos River Authority has operated and maintained the Clute-Richwood Regional Sewerage System under a 20-year, cost-reimbursable Agreement with the Cities of Clute and Richwood that expired on September 30, 2020, and was extended for one year through September 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Cities have requested another one-year extension of the existing Agreement to begin on October 1, 2021, and to expire on September 30, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to execute a one-year extension of the Clute-Richwood Regional Sewerage System Agreement to begin on October 1, 2021, and to expire on September 30, 2022."
