- 87th Legislature
  - Bills Filed: 7327
  - Bills Passed: 1175 (16%)
- 86th Legislature
  - Bills Filed: 7795
  - Bills Passed: 1564 (20%)
- 85th Legislature
  - Bills Filed: 7003
  - Bills Passed: 1314 (19%)



- **HB 2225-**Relating to the powers and duties of the Parks and Wildlife Department regarding the Texas Water Trust.
- **SB 997-**Relating to procedural requirements for the review of a contractual rate charged for the furnishing of raw or treated water or water or sewer service.
- **SB 2154-**Relating to the membership of the Public Utility Commission of Texas.



• **SB 601-**Relating to the creation and activities of the Texas Produced Water Consortium.

- **SB 1225-**Relating to the authority of a governmental body impacted by a catastrophe to temporarily suspend the requirements of the public information law.
- **HB 1154-**Relating to the requirement that certain political subdivisions cause certain information to be posted on an internet website.



- **HB 2730-**Relating to the acquisition of real property by an entity with eminent domain authority and the regulation of easement or right-of-way agents.
- SB 726-Relating to establishing actual progress for the purposes of determining the right to repurchase real property from a condemning entity.



# **Contracting and Employment**

- **HB 692-**Relating to retainage requirements for certain public works construction projects.
- **SB 19-**Relating to prohibited contracts with companies that discriminate against the firearm or ammunition industries.
- **HB 1118-**Relating to state agency and local government compliance with cybersecurity training requirements.



- **SB 3-**Relating to preparing for, preventing, and responding to weather emergencies and power outages; increasing the amount of administrative and civil penalties.
- **SB 600-**Relating to an inventory of dams controlled by river authorities.



- Sunset is not designed to tell an agency what they do well, only where they can improve.
- Review process lasted from June 2020-Janury 2021.
- Sunset staff was extremely professional and easy to work with.
- Process included multiple meetings with each BRA department, along with multiple follow-up meetings.
- Also included meetings with specific areas such as treatment ops and the lakes.
- Requests for Information (RFI's) received weekly. These included multiple questions which included sub-questions.



- RFI's involved production of a large amount of information/documentation
- Considerable staff time spent on producing responses to RFIs.
- Sunset report produced contained minimal findings/recommendations, some statutory and some management.
- Report initially adopted by Sunset Commission in January 2021
- Legislation filed as a result passed both chambers unanimously and signed by the Governor.
- BRA up for sunset again in advance of the 2033 session.



- **HB 1570-**Relating to the Brazos River Authority, following recommendations of the Sunset Advisory Commission; specifying grounds for the removal of a member of the board of directors.
  - Board member removal
  - Board member training
  - Public remarks at Board meetings
  - Complaint tracking system
  - Board Policy/Staff Day-to-day separation



## Sunset Mgmt Reccs

- Project management/implementation
  - Project prioritization
  - Info on project progression/expenditures
  - Board strategic plan involvement
  - Public engagement policy for water supply projects
- Purchasing
  - Objective criteria for professional service contract awards
  - Document vendor performance
  - Adoption of basic contracting BMPs

- Changes to BRA procedures
- BRA Board bylaw and policy changes (September)
- Fall 2022-Sunset staff to return, with State Auditor's Office (SAO)

  - SAO staff checks compliance with mgmt reccs
