## History

- Federal Communications Commission adopts Part 90 Subpart B Public Safety Radio Pool Rules in 1997
  - Nationwide interoperability and mutual aid channels established
  - Dedicated frequencies
  - Part 90 License required to utilize
  - State/regional advisory committees required
- 77<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature (2001)
  - Interagency Radio Work Group (IWRG)
  - State agency communications network
- IWRG mandates that state agency communications network be expanded to include all public safety agencies in the state
- TxDPS issues first MOU (2003)
  - Participants may utilize the state-licensed frequencies
  - BRA executes MOU
- BRA Board of Directors adopts National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the protocol to be used in responding to emergencies (2006)

## Obligations of BRA

- Use interoperability frequencies for the intended purpose of coordination between emergency response agencies
- Prioritize use of the interoperability frequencies, versus other frequencies, during an emergency response
- Participate in joint training exercises
- Adoption of the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the protocol to be used in responding to emergencies or disaster incidents
- No fee required to utilize interoperability frequencies
