## Clute-Richwood Wastewater Treatment Plant





## Summary

- Four million gallon per day plant and reuse facility
- Four BRA employees
- Treats wastewater from the Cities of Clute and Richwood
- BRA has been operating the facility since Oct. 1, 2000, under a cost-reimbursable contract
- Original 20-year contract expired September 30, 2020
- Two one-year extensions since
- Cities went through an RFP process late last year
- BRA selected for new contract
- 2023 proposed budget is \$1,130,671; BRA Management Fee is \$56,534
- Recommend Board grant authorization for General Manager/CEO to execute new 5-year
   O&M agreement



## Resolution

"BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to execute a new five-year agreement with the Cities of Clute and Richwood for the continued operation and maintenance of the Clute-Richwood Regional Sewerage System by the Brazos River Authority with a term beginning on October 1, 2022, and ending on September 30, 2027."
