Proposed Changes

The maximum term for a new long-term raw water supply contract will be thirty-five years; provided, however, the length of the term for all new long-term contracts will be rounded down to the closest year ending in zero or five. Contract renewals and extensions will also be similarly limited unless an existing contract provides otherwise. Renewals and extensions are at the sole discretion of the Brazos River Authority and will not be considered until ~~one~~three years prior to expiration of an existing contract.

In the event a customer requests an extension of a contract prior to three years from its expiration because the extension is necessary to receive funding from the Texas Water Development Board, then the Brazos River Authority, in its sole discretion, will determine whether to grant an early extension.
