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


# ***What is Interruptible Water?***

- **Firm water from reservoirs not used in the previous year**
- **Amount available varies from year to year depending on past water usage**
- **Availability established annually by the Board**
- **Sold at System Rate (Ag Rate for irrigation)**
- **Began supplying in 2008**



# Interruptible Water 2008 - 2024



**\*2024 - IW was not made available initially at the November BOD meeting due to on-going drought and the Stage 4 declaration at Lake Proctor. 41,913 af of IW was authorized at the March BOD meeting for areas outside of the Little River Basin (LR system continued to be impacted by drought). The remaining 13,023 af of IW was authorized at the July BOD meeting due to improved drought conditions in the LR System.**



- **Authorize the General Manager/CEO to enter Interruptible Water Availability Agreements for the total calculated amount of 53,683 acre-feet for 2025**



**“BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby approves a Safety Factor of 0.25 for use in determining the amounts of Interruptible Water to make available in calendar year 2025.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes the General Manager/CEO to make up to 53,683 acre-feet of Interruptible Water available in calendar year 2025.”**
