TWC 49 vs. GC 2269

- Currently under TWC Chapter 49
 - Includes bidding thresholds
- GC 2269 was adopted in 2011
 - Moved select provisions of LGC 271 to GC 2267 (now 2269)
 - Applies only to public works projects
 - Allowed river authorities to opt in
 - Did not have bidding thresholds
- If opt in, it will only apply to public works projects, other construction contracts will still be procured under TWC Chapter 49.



“BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Brazos River Authority hereby authorizes and elects the use of Texas Government Code Chapter 2269 to supersede the law, rule, or regulation of the Texas Water Code Chapter 49 as it relates to procurement methods for construction contracts for public works projects.”






