



# Lake Granbury Two Slip Boathouse Replacement

The existing two-slip floating boathouse was installed in 1995. The boathouse is located in downtown Granbury just off Business 377, approximately 13 miles from the dam. Its central location makes it ideal for responding to calls for service in the central and upper reaches of the lake in a timely manner. The boathouse is more than 25 years old, and its supporting metal frame has corroded.

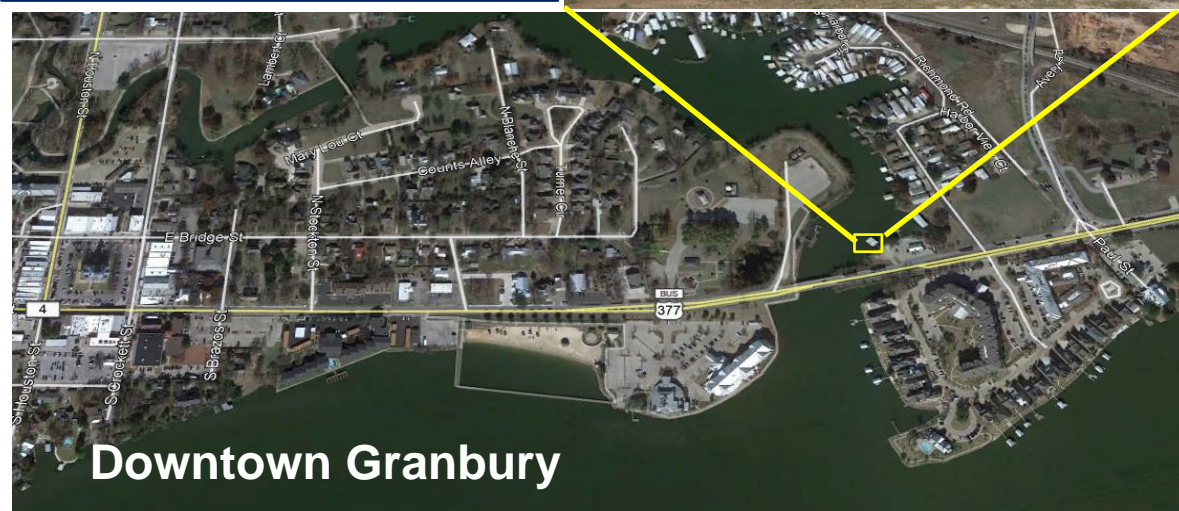


Current Boathouse

## The Project

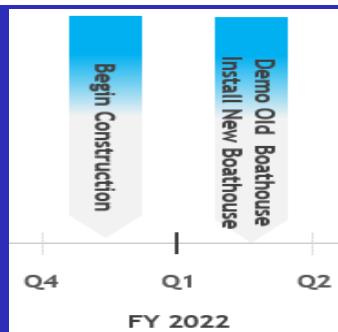
This project will remove the current downtown two-slip boathouse and replace it with a new two-slip boathouse. This project will allow the BRA to continue to house a Patrol Boat at this critical location and to ensure rapid response to calls for service from the central and upper areas of the lake.

## Current Project Status 10/29/2021

- The BRA developed the specifications for the Request for Bids in-house
- The contract was executed in FY21 Q4
- Construction of the new boathouse is progressing
- Demolition and removal of the current boathouse is complete
- Project completion is planned for FY22 Q1
