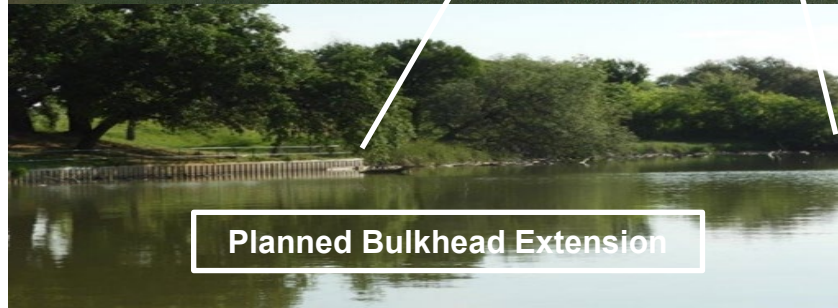
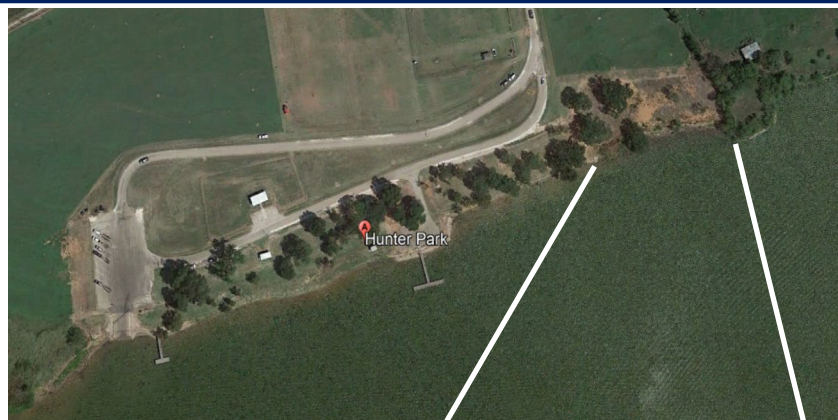




Hunter Park Bulkhead Extension



Hunter Park is one of five parks owned and operated by the BRA at Lake Granbury. It is located at 2800 Weatherford Hwy. The park is free to the public and includes picnic tables, restroom, boat ramp, and fishing pier.

The Project



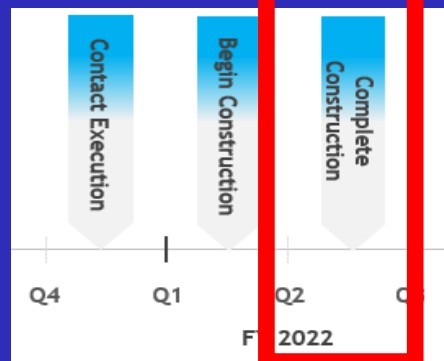
In 2014, the BRA installed a steel bulkhead to arrest shoreline erosion at Hunter Park from the Boat Ramp to just east of the fishing pier. The project extended the steel bulkhead from the end of the existing bulkhead approximately 335 feet east to the property line and includes 75 – 85 feet of a natural drainage area for habitat improvement.

Current Project Status 3/18/2022

- Construction was completed on December 20, 2021
- The drainage area improvements completed February 2022
- Final payment and release on February 25, 2022
