

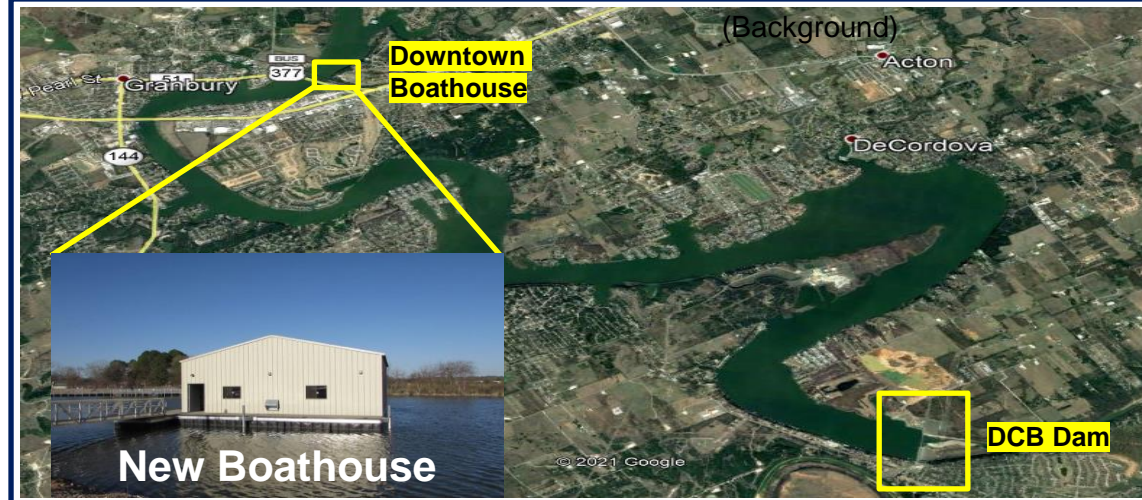


Lake Granbury Two Slip Boathouse Replacement

The old two-slip floating boathouse was installed in 1995. The boathouse is located in downtown Granbury just off Business 377, approximately 13 miles from the dam. Its central location makes it ideal for responding to calls for service in the central and upper reaches of the lake in a timely manner. The boathouse was more than 25 years old, and its supporting metal frame was corroded.

The Project

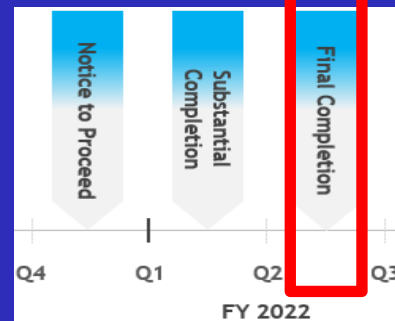
This project removed the old downtown two-slip boathouse and replaced it with a new two-slip boathouse. This project allows the BRA to continue to house a Patrol Boat at this critical location and to ensure rapid response to calls for service from the central and upper areas of the lake.

Current Project Status 4/1/2022

- The BRA developed the specifications for the Request for Bids in-house
- Notice to Proceed was issued in August 2021
- The project was substantially complete November 10, 2021
- **Final completion February 25, 2022**
